# Kratom and 7-OH Products are Illegal in California

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has determined that kratom and 7-OH (7-Hydroxymitragynine) products are unsafe and **illegal to sell**. CDPH is working with the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) and the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration (CDTFA) on retailer education and enforcement.

## Why is it dangerous?

**7-OH is 13x stronger than morphine.** It's a type of opioid that is found naturally in kratom then artificially concentrated and sold in unregulated products.

**Regular use can lead to addiction, withdrawal, and overdose.**
